

Salt Log Outfitters Rules and Expectations

Killing of a Buck less than 8 points and 16 inches wide will result in a \$550 fine.

Antler points must be at least 1 inch long to count as a point.

Killing of a spike or button buck will result in a \$550 fine, and will count as your buck for the trip.

Fines must be paid the same day, before you are allowed to hunt again.

Anyone who does not pay their fine will be asked to leave the property, forfeit the remainder of their hunt, and all money paid towards that hunt. Refusal to leave will be considered illegal trespass, and the incident will be referred to local law enforcement.

Our expectation from guests is they conduct themselves in a polite, congenial manner with staff and other guests. Violent or disorderly conduct is unacceptable. Anyone acting in a disrespectful, disorderly, or violent manner will be forced to leave the property, forfeit the remainder of their hunt, and all money paid towards that hunt.

Lying about shooting an animal, and then our later discovering shot and abandoned game, will prohibit your being able to hunt the property again on any future occasion.

Not following the rules set by your guides will also result in not being allowed to hunt the property again.

There is a \$25.00 cleaning fee, per animal, when the guide staff cleans a client's kill. There is also a \$25.00 charge when the guide staff capes animals for trophy mounts. This fee is due at the time of the service.
